The group met on December 16 to decorate the Youth Room for Christmas and also to decorate cookies. A great time was had by all and I can't wait for the next activity. Our Education Committee is getting filled up and I am excited to start working with all of the members in 2019. We have added all teachers for youth Sunday School classes to the committee, as well as a few individuals. Some may not be able to attend every meeting but will have opportunities to provide input nonetheless. Motion to approve minutes from last month: Chuck made motion to accept as read – approved unanimously.

Committee Reports

Finance – Chuck Petzoldt

Continue to operate at deficit

\$100,000 bequest received from Marsha Griffin estate – Customary 10% goes to Missions – remainder put into General Fund per vote at last Finance Committee meeting.

Budget from Charge Conference – 2019 projected expenses are \$596,000, and projected revenue is \$416,000, leaving a deficit of \$180,000 going into 2019.

63 pledges totaling \$158,000 received thus far.

Treasurer's Report – Submitted to Finance Committee

Endowment – Chuck Petzoldt

Met with Casey Martin from Raymond James – will not request any money from Endowments at this time

Trustees – Jon Lohrbach

Ramp update - Jon will contact another company for a bid. Electrical heat for ramp priced at \$6278. Motion made by Jon Lohrbach to table ramp at this time and to look at options. Seconded by Dennis Reidel, voted on and passed.

Sanctuary Air Handling unit repair - (Jim Morrise) Permanent repairs have been made. Cost of repair had been estimated at \$3500 when actual bill was \$5964. This bill is being paid.

Church Lockbox for fire department – Troy ordered it – will contact Jon when it arrives. We will then work with the fire marshal for placement.

Calendar 2019 budget prep and approval: Board voted to submit keeping Calendar 2019 Board of Trustees budget total at \$47,850. Motion made by Dennis Reidel and seconded by Doug Peshak, voted on and passed.

Election of Pastor Dan: Motion made by Karen Blackwell and seconded by Doug Peshak, voted on and passed.

Discussion of updated endowment report: Motion made by Jon L. to table till next meeting and seconded by Karen B. Voted on and passed.

Computer for Lisa Bailey - Motion made to allocate no more than \$1500 for phone system modifications in the kitchen, and computer purchase (laptop) for Pastor Dan and reallocation of Pastor Dan's present computer for Lisa Bailey, along with the reallocation of the existing kitchen phone for Lisa. Motion made by Jon Lohrbach and seconded by John Deets. Voted on and passed.

Phone replacement in kitchen: See above.

Phil Johnson made presentation for a large wooden cross for the front of the Sanctuary. Phil and his wife will be paying all cross-related expenses. Board approved. Jon Lohrbach made the motion for go ahead for the project and John Deets seconded, it was voted on and passed.

Parking lot (long-term projects)

Parsonage: Incoming Bills (Total to date) \$31,721.09

Basement ceiling and Floor shoe will be completed later this year by Doug Peshak

Sidewalk repair (damaged by Tuck pointers) - is being replaced. Delayed due to weather.

Copier machine replacement

APPROVED however will have to wait till March meeting which will require approval by next year's Trustees Board. Purchase of the Xerox C7025T would be \$4967 plus tax. This amount includes training with the new machine and analyst services. Monthly maintenance will be \$15. The only additional cost will be \$0.0101 per b/w copy and \$0.0604 per color copy. – Karen Blackwell moved purchase of the Xerox C7025T; Doug Peshak second. Vote was unanimous.

Karen Blackwell will be spearheading a tree replacement plan for the one removed from the front of the church.

The congregation will be asked if they want to do a (in memory of) tree – Karen will also investigate what kind of tree and best place to plant.

Investigate options for front steps at the parsonage. Jim Morrise will investigate with Mason City Tile and Marble (Russ)

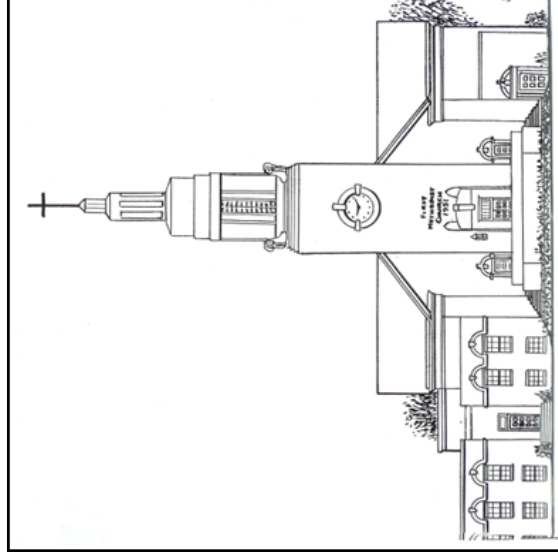
